
Hole In One Endorsement

By endorsement, the following changes are made to **Your Policy**:

Definitions

The definition of **Specified Event** is deleted in its entirety and is replaced by the following:

Specified Event occurs when a **Contestant** in a **Contest** who complies with the **Conditions of Participation** hits a **Hole-in-one** and **You** have promised to give the **Contestant** the **Prize**.

The following additional definitions are included in **Your Policy**:

Ball, Flagstick, Hole, Tee Markers and **Teeing Ground**, each have meanings ascribed to them respectively in the Rules of Golf.

Contest Cuphole means the **Cuphole(s)** for a **Contest Hole** while it is in its usual position on the green and is marked with a **Flagstick**

Contest Hole refers to any hole on a **Course** used in the **Contest** where the minimum distance (measured from **Tee Markers** to **Flagstick**) for men is at least 150 metres and for women is at least 140 metres.

Course refers to any golf course in Australia listed in **Your Schedule**

Golf Ball has the meaning ascribed to 'ball' in the **Rules of Golf**

A **Hole-in-one** occurs when (on a **Contest Hole**) a **Contestant** on their first stroke for that **Contest Hole**, hits a **Golf Ball** from the **Teeing Ground** into the **Contest Cuphole**.

Round of Golf means 18 holes of play

Rules of Golf means the Rules of Golf in force at the date of the **Competition** as published from time to time by Golf Australia or in default, by R&A.

Section 2: Conditions – Your Obligations

The following additional **Conditions** are included in **Your Policy** following Clause 2.4:

2.5 **You** cannot change the set-up of any **Contest Hole(s)** without **Our** written permission. During a **Contest** the **Contest Cuphole(s)** must remain in its normal position with regard to the **Teeing Ground** and green.

2.6 **Contest Supervisor(s)** must watch play at each **Contest Hole** at all times during the **Contest**.

2.7 The **Contest** must be played in groups of no fewer than two players.

Section 3: Conditions Of Participation

The following additional **Conditions of Participation** are included in **Your Policy** following Clause 3.1(e):

f) any person who has previously won an insured hole in one contest.

The following additional **Conditions of Participation** are included in **Your Policy** following Clause 3.4:

3.5 **Contest Supervisor(s)** must watch play at each **Contest Hole** at all times during the **Contest**.

3.6 The **Contestant** must finish the entire **Round of Golf**, complete the scorecard and have it signed by his or her playing partner(s) and the **Contest Supervisor(s)**.

3.7 The **Contest** must be played in groups of no fewer than two players.

3.8 The following are not **Specified Events**:

Hole In One Endorsement (cont'd)

- a) *Mulligans;*
 - b) *When a stroke is replayed for any reason including the ball landing out of bounds;*
 - c) **Contestant** *who takes more than one attempt at a **Contest Hole** during a Contest regardless of the outcome of the stroke, unless the Contestant is 'rounding out' a group by taking an extra shot, in which circumstance the first stroke is eligible to be a Specified Event.*
- 3.9 *The material and equipment used must conform to the regulations of the International Professional or Amateur Golfers' Association.*
- 3.10 *The green at the insured hole may not be specially prepared or differ in any way from its normal playing condition. The hole on the green may not be located in such a way as to make it easier to hit a hole-in-one.*
- 3.11 *The **Rules of Golf** otherwise apply.*
- All other terms, conditions, exclusions and limitations contained in **Your Policy** remain unchanged.*
