Calliden appointed as NSW Government Home Warranty Insurance Agent.

On Wednesday 2 June 2010, the NSW Government confirmed that following a comprehensive tender process, Calliden Insurance Limited (Calliden) had been appointed as one of the insurance agents for the new Government-underwritten scheme for home warranty insurance.

The new Government-underwritten scheme will come into effect from 1 July 2010 and will be underwritten by the NSW Self Insurance Corporation.

Under the new arrangement, the NSW Self Insurance Corporation plans to introduce new underwriting and claims guidelines and a single pricing structure for all builders.

In the interim, current underwriting criteria and pricing structures will apply until new guidelines are issued by the NSW Self Insurance Corporation.
